## Jan 10 (Monday) – MARRIAGES

### Instructions for Christian Households

- Ephesians 5:21-33** <sup>21</sup> Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. <sup>22</sup> Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. <sup>24</sup> Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her <sup>26</sup> to make her holy, cleansing<sup>[b]</sup> her by the washing with water through the word, <sup>27</sup> and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. <sup>29</sup> After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and care for their body, just as Christ does the church— <sup>30</sup> for we are members of his body. <sup>31</sup> "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh."<sup>[c]</sup> <sup>32</sup> This is a profound mystery—but I am talking about Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.
- Proverbs 20:6-7** Many a man claims to have unfailing love, but a faithful man who can find? The righteous man leads a blameless life; blessed are his children after him.
- Proverbs 19:14** Houses and wealth are inherited from parents, but a prudent wife is from the LORD.
- Hebrews 13:4-7** Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?" Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith

### *Pray for the father*

- Pray that he will love his wife as Christ loved the Church.

- "Husbands, love your wives just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her... husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies... he feeds and cares for it, just as Christ does the church" (Eph.5:25-32)
- "Husbands love your wives and do not be harsh with them" (Col.3:19).
- "Husbands in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life so that nothing will hinder your prayers" (1 Pet.3:7).
- Pray that the father will be the priest in the home by giving guidance and praying for his family.
- Pray that the father will exercise his authority given to him by God and not leave it to his wife.
- Pray that the husband will be reasonable towards his wife. Pray for the husband for patience with his wife and for self control with regard to his family.
- Pray that he will be aware of his wife's need for love, safety and security, together with all her other needs and that he will pay attention to them.
- Pray that he will exercise leadership (spiritually as well as socially) at home and that he will provide for his family.

#### ***Pray for the mother***

- Pray that she will submit to her husband in everything as the church is submissive to Christ
- (Eph.5:22-24)
- "Wives in the same way be submissive to your husbands so that if any of them do not believe the Word they may be won over without words by the behavior of their wives when they see the purity and reverence of your lives. Your beauty should not come from outward adornment such as braided hair and the wearing of gold jewelry and fine clothes" (1 Pet.3:1-3) "...the wife must respect her husband" (Eph.5:33).
- Pray for a quiet and gentle spirit and that she will know when to keep quiet. Pray for the wife for patience with her husband.
- Pray that she will respect her husband and that she will not try to dominate or prescribe to him.
- Pray that she will not complain about her husband but will respect him and try to meet his needs.
- Pray that the wife will accept her husband's leadership.
- Pray that the wife will realize that her husband is a fellow sinner, that she will have patience with his faults and that she will allow him the freedom to be himself.
- Specifically pray against a domineering attitude in the wife (especially in cases where she is spiritually stronger than her husband), because this can cause endless damage to the children. Also pray against any form of manipulation on the part of the wife. Manipulation is always negative.

#### ***What to pray for the children***

- Pray for obedience and submissiveness to the parents.
- Pray for their salvation and for the spiritual growth of those already saved.
- Pray for their physical growth, health and good eating habits.
- Pray for their education and sports activities.
- Pray for their intellectual development and for their growing in wisdom and knowledge.
- Pray for the figures of authority with whom they have daily contact: teachers, sports coaches, parents, grandfathers, grandmothers, etc.
- Pray for their social development and for a pure walk in life so that they may discern
- between right and wrong; that they will be able to resist temptation and that they will
- choose the right friends.
- Resist the evil one who will try to destroy their lives.
- While they're young, begin to pray for the right choice of career and marriage partners.



- Pray that they will love God and his Word and also pray for their joy in life.
- Pray for the right friends for them.

### **General**

- Pray against the spirit of divorce, lust and impurity.
- Especially pray against the following sins; that the Holy Spirit will convict people of these
- and that they will turn from them: homosexuality, co-habitation, adultery, child molesting,
- suicide, alcohol and drug abuse.
- Pray against the involvement of a third party in the marriage.
- Pray for an open relationship and good communication in the marriage.
- Pray for deep conviction of sin and that the husband and wife will walk in the Light together.
- Pray for understanding of each other's needs and the ability and willingness to meet those needs.
- Pray against every form of selfishness, self-indulgence and wilfulness in the marriage.
- Pray that there will be no misunderstandings. The single, biggest problem in marriages, is misunderstanding.
- When there are specific problems in the marriage, e.g., jealousy, misuse of alcohol and extra-marital relationships, one must pray specifically for these matters.
- Pray for the parents in their raising and handling of their children.
- Pray for forgiveness, that marriage partners will forget the past and forgive one another for what happened in the past.
- Pray for widowers, widows and couples who are unable to have children and also for children without parents and children in orphanages.
- Pray for the single and lonely
- people who long for the security of a family.
- Pray for children who have run away from home and for children whose friends have a bad influence on them.

- Pray for missionaries involved in technical support, construction, medical assistance, media, teaching, and other vital ministries.
- Pray for missions leaders at the local, district, and national levels, asking God to provide wisdom and direction in the decisions they make.

#### **PRAY FOR THE MISSIONARY FAMILY**

- Pray for new missionaries on the field as they adjust to being away from family, friends, and things familiar.
- Pray for missionary children and youth, that they will adjust to the various cultures and feel at home.
- Pray for missionary kids who return to the US after high school graduation and have to stay (often without family) to begin their college education or vocation.

- Pray for missionaries as they minister in evangelism, church planting, training of national leaders, and compassion ministries, that the Lord will empower them as they face the challenges of ministering cross-culturally.

#### **GUIDANCE AND PROTECTION**

- Pray for wisdom and understanding as missionaries deal with unique customs and cultures.
- Pray for new missionaries as they learn unfamiliar languages, that they will quickly learn to communicate the message of Christ’s love and hope.
- Pray for strength and healing among missionary families who often are exposed to disease.
- Pray for a mighty move of the Holy Spirit that will cause millions of people to come to Christ.
- Pray for a hedge of God’s protection around missionaries serving in difficult and sensitive parts of the world.
- Pray for favor with government agencies so the gospel can be proclaimed and the Church established.
- Pray for a powerful anointing upon the preached Word around the world.

**PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARIES & MINISTRY PARTNERS** Pray that God would refresh and stir up the divine call, gifts, talents, abilities, skills and every prophetic word spoken over the lives of each of our Missionaries as well as their Leadership & Ministry Team.

- Pray that the spirit of oneness, unity, peace, forgiveness, reconciliation, encouragement and kindred spirit would prevail upon the relationship of our Missionary families, their Leadership & Ministry team as well as their congregation.
- Pray that God would open doors of opportunities to minister in the area of their Missions.
